WHERE TO SHOP

Aventura Mall

Florida's largest super-regional mall housing five departments stores including Nordstrom, Bloomingdale's, JC Penny, Sears and two Macy stores. The mall offers shoppers early and extended shopping hours, a 24-screen AMC movie theatre, casual dining options and nearly 300 stores accented by Abercrombie & Fitch, Lacoste, Michael Kors, True Religion Jeans, The Disney Store, Sephora and Louis Vitton.

Bayside Marketplace & Marina

Nestled in the heart of downtown Miami is Bayside Marketplace & Marina. It lies sandwiched between The American Airlines Arena and Bayfront Park. Bayside, Miami's most popular visitor attraction is a multi-level open-air complex filled with shops, restaurants, daily boat tours and nightly live entertainment. Whether you visit by day or by night, Bayside has something fun for families, couples or individuals. Don't miss the opportunity to take a picture by The Torch of Friendship and The Lily Pond. Collins Avenue Shops

Several of the Art Deco Districts most colorful buildings on Collins Avenue are home to distinctive clothing, jewelry and shoe stores like Nicole Miller, Urban Outfitters, Banana Republic, Armani, Puma, Kenneth Cole and Nine West. This ever-expanding shopping area has extended north with the addition of The Webster on 12th street and Atrium on 19th Street. This area is commonly the main destination for bikini-clad shoppers buying the hottest fashion for nightlife.

Coral Gables - Miracle Mile

The downtown commercial district, including Miracle Mile, was designed by George Merrick, who could boast that every business in Coral Gables was less than a two-block walk. Downtown Coral Gables is a pedestrian-friendly neighborhood infused with a chic European feel. Anchored by tree-lined Miracle Mile, this vibrant area is home to Mediterranean architecture, yet boasts some of Miami's hippest boutiques, acclaimed restaurants, respected art galleries and world-class hotels. With more than 200 retailers and 70 restaurants, Downtown Coral Gables and Miracle Mile is a sophisticated destination to shop, dine, play, live and work. Dolphin Mall

Miami's largest retail bargain mall offers shoppers incredible deals from more than 240 value-oriented stores and a wide range of dining & entertainment. The mall has 16 anchor stores, 100,000-square-foot Bass Pro Shops, a Burlington Coat Factory, Neiman Marcus Last Call Clearance Center, Marshalls, Home Goods, OFF 5th Saks Fifth Avenue Outlet Store, Ross Dress for Less, Old Navy and The Sports Authority. It is also home to a 19 cinemas movie megaplex with stadium seating.

Downtown Miami

Downtown Miami serves as the city's urban high-rise residential area and the main business district. Cultural landmarks like the Gusman Center for the Performing Arts, the Miami Art Museum, Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts and the Historical Museum of Southern Florida are located here. Late 19th and early 20th century architectural designed buildings including the city's first courthouse line Flagler Street, Miami's first road. This low-key option offers several big brand chain stores such as Bebe, Guess, Anthropologie, Crocs, Kiels and The Apple Store, in addition to many lesser known local art, jewelry and clothing boutiques. At night Lincoln Road is filled with talented and colorful street performers lining the walkways, providing entertainment and added fun.

Miami Design District

Located just north of Downtown Miami, this pedestrian friendly area offers some of the world's leading designers, contemporary and traditional furniture showrooms, antiques dealers, art galleries and retail spaces.

Sawgrass Mills

Located in the city of Sunrise, just west of Ft. Lauderdale, Sawgrass is the largest outlet mall in the state of Florida. If you have the time, energy and patience for an all-out shopping spree this is the place with 13 department stores and more than 350 shops offering reduced prices on clothing, jewelry, home furnishings, electronics, accessories, children clothes, toys and games. The Oasis wing of the mall has additional stores, delicious restaurants, a movie theatre and entertainment.

Shoppes at Bal Harbour
