Coastal breezes for desert homes

The Betsy is a landmark Miami Beach luxury boutique hotel (thebetsyhotel.com) that reopened this spring after a complete renovation. Interior designers Diamante Pedersoli and Carmelina Santoro (designers for such icons as Ralph Lauren and Bulgari retail stores) created light, breezy, soft palette tableaus of white rooms splashed with lavenders, Tuscan ochre and spring greens. This is a tropical colonial design with ebony hardwood floors, light linen curtains, white lacquered furniture and sandy colored accents — a familiar look for desert homes.

The Hamilton floor lamp [\$199] resembles the classic pharmacy light. Available at Pottery Barn.

It's all about comfort and light fabrics. This Arlington club chair upholstered in a white canvas [\$949-\$1,199] is available in a variety of fabrics. Available at Pottery Barn.

The jute boucle black-bordered rug [World Market, \$59 to \$149] offers a textural counterpoint to light, smooth linen and cotton.
