The name is ultimately derived from the french bourbon dynasty, although it is disputed whether bourbon county in kentucky or bourbon street in new orleans inspired the whiskey's name. Bourbon has been distilled since the 18th century. The use of the term "bourbon" for the whiskey has been traced to the 1820's, and the term began to be used consistently in kentucky in the 1870's.

## **RYE**

Rye whiskey was the prevalent whiskey of the northeastern states, especially pennsylvania and maryland. Pittsburgh was the center of rye whiskey production in the late 1700s and early 1800's. By 1808, allegheny county farmers were selling one half barrel for each man, woman and child in the country. Rye whiskey largely disappeared after prohibition. A few brands, such as old overholt, survived it, although by the late 1960's even pennsylvania names such as old overholt were being distilled only in kentucky.

Scotch whisky evolved from a Scottish drink called uisge beatha, which means “water of life”. The earliest record of distillation in Scotland occurred as long ago as 1494, as documented in the exchequer rolls, which were records of royal income and expenditure.

## HIGHLANDS & ISLANDS

Fruitcake and oak flirt with heather and smoke in highland whiskies. Wild seas and impenetrable moorland dominate the landscape, creating a breeding ground for powerful peaty drams, whilst still leaving room for floral, silky elegance the versatility of the islands accommodates both feathery citrus flavours and smoking peaty noses. Arran, Mull, Jura, Skye and Orkney champion brine, oil, black pepper, heather and honey. For challenging, volcanic drams full of maritime notes that are anything but tame, island malts are your calling.

## BRANDY

*The origins of brandy were clearly tied to the development of distillation. While the process was known in classical times, it wasn't used for significant beverage production until the 15th century. Initially wine was distilled as a preservation method and as a way to make it easier for merchants to transport. It is also thought that wine was originally distilled to lessen the tax which was assessed by volume. The intent was to add the water removed by distillation back to the brandy shortly before consumption. It was discovered that after having been stored in wooden casks, the resulting product had improved over the original distilled spirit.*
