Juan Carlos Zaldivar is a Cuban-born filmmaker and video artist whose work explores themes of migration, technology and personal identity. (Front Desk & Lobby Bar Floor)

Ken Regan was a photographer and photojournalist, known for his intimate portraits of celebrities and celebrities. (LT Restaurant)

Laurence Fink was a photographer and educator, best known for his black-and-white images of people at parties and in other social situations. (Corridor, 1st FL)

Laura Paresky Gould is a graphic designer, animator, photographer and fine artist who calls photography 'meditation with your eyes open'. (Atrium- Dec 4 event, The ORB -Spring 2026)

Lianne Jedeikin Goldsmith paints photograph-like images on vintage wallpaper; she was born in Zimbabwe and lives in LA. (Carlton Room)

Liz'n'Bow - Liz Ferrer and Bow Ty's work spans various mediums including digital art, tech, sculpture, music, video, and performance art. (The ORB outside)

Lynn Gilbert is a photographer and author best known for her portraits of illustrious women from the 1920s to the 1980s. (LT Restaurant, Corridor, 1st FL)

Mark Seliger's art photography career spans over 30 years and includes work for Rolling Stone, Vanity Fair, GQ, and Italian Voque. (Stairwell 1st FL)

Max Steven Grossman is a contemporary digital photographer. His series include bookscapes, landscapes, and nature. (Betsy Elevators)

Philippe Halsman began to take photographs in Paris in the 1930s – and was known as a 'master of lighting'. (LT Restaurant)

Ray Tenorio is a Cuban born, Berlin-educated, mixed media artist whose work is inspired by his Latin roots, Expressionism, urban mythology and fashion. (Boardroom)

Robert Whitman was an iconic Prince photographer, with the ability to reveal the common humanity that unites us all. (Stairwell, 1st FL)

Robin Hill is a UK-born photographer who straddles the boundaries between architecture, design and fine art. (ORB Passage inside)

Steve Dozier is a career photojournalist and art photographer whose work has taken him around the world, and back to Miami Beach street life. (LT Annex, Corridor, 3rd Floor)

Tamary Kudita is a Zimbabwean rising photographic artist, exploring societal dualities using textiles and historical references to tell her own stories. (Carlton Room Stairs)

Timothy White has photographed film actors and music artists, and shot for movie posters, magazine and music album covers. (Corridor & Stairwell 1st FL)

Todd Monaghan says "My (art) work is to find inspiration in the dance and celebration of the practice. This is my making process." (LT Lobby, Carlton Room Stairs)

Public Art

The Betsy Orb (in The Alley) is an egg-like sculpture that serves as a third-floor skybridge between the historic Betsy Hotel and a neighboring building (formerly the Carlton Hotel). Its function is to physically and symbolically connect the two wings of the hotel and to act as a piece of public art.

The Betsy Poetry Rail (in The Alley) is an homage to global poets who have shaped Miami literature by including their diverse, historic, and contemporary voices – with words cut by water jets into steel. Stop by the piece to read poetry by Muhammad Ali, Richard Blanco, Adrian Castro, Chenjerai Hove, Langston Hughes, Donald Justice, Campbell McGrath, Geoffrey Philp, Carlos Pintado, Hyam Plutzik, Gerald Stern, and Julie Marie Wade.

Zimbabwean Shona Art (in the Atrium) is a modern stone sculpture collection, from a movement that emerged in the mid-20th century, drawing on ancient traditions of stone carving from the Great Zimbabwe civilization. The collection is on loan from the Plutzik Goldwasser Family.

Andy Sweet documented South Beach with a particular focus on the Jewish Holocaust survivors. (Betsy Elevators, Lobby Bar)

Annie Leibovitz is a celebrated American photographer best known for her engaging and dramatic celebrity portraits. (located in LT Lobby)

Anthony Hayden-Guest's cartoons and illustrations have appeared widely, and he is known for maintaining an exhaustive lifelong social calendar. (location tbd)

Art Shay was a celebrated American photographer and writer whose work appeared in Life, Time, and Sports Illustrated magazines. (located in LT Restaurant, Corridor and Stairwell, 1st FL)

Bob Bonis was the US Tour manager for The Beatles and Rolling Stones, from 1964-66. The Betsy's museum collection is more than 300 works. (LT Restaurant, Corridors and Stairways, property-wide)

Bob Gruen is an American author and storyteller known for his legendary rock and roll photographs. (LT Corridor and Stairwell, 1st FL)

Carlos Andres Cruz is a Bogota- based photographer, who specializes in creating images that reflect the dynamism, joy, and character of dogs. (Underground Gallery)

Christo and Jeanne-Claude – leaders in 'Nouveau' Realism- are credited with large-scale, global, monumental, site-specific environmental installations. (The Gallery)

Dalia Dreszer uses photography and digital manipulation to create new and derived compositions that incorporate natural elements and Al. (Carlton Room, Corridor, 3rd FL)

David Godlis is an artist photographer whose work celebrates the worlds of Punk, Cinema, and Street life/experience. (LT Restaurant and Lobby)

David LaChapelle is an American photographer, music video director, and film director whose work touches history and fashion. (LT Restaurant)

Don Hunstein's iconic images celebrate his 30 years as a staff photographer at Columbia Records shooting the greats. (Corridor & Stairwell,1st FL)

Gabe Kirchheimer shoots non-religious spiritual events, focused on outsider art, social justice, and nature, like Burning Man. (Corridor, 1st FL)

Gered Mankowitz is an English photographer who focused his career in the music industry and fashion for over five decades. (LT Restaurant)

Ira Wagner's photographic work focuses on the urban landscape and built environment – and he's a former Wall Street banker. (Carlton Room)

Jane Rose is Keith Richards' longtime manager, a member of the Rolling Stones inner circle, and a skilled photographer. (LT Restaurant)
